## Questions for discussion and meditation:

I. Why does Paul remind believer's of God's peace when he calls them to be active in their sanctification (eg. 1Thess. 5:23)? How does Christ' resurrection assure believers of God's peace? How did Christ become the believer's Great Shepherd? How was Christ' blood a fulfillment of God's covenant of grace? II. How does the second part of this benediction show believers that Jesus also came to make them holy? Describe God's work in our sanctification according to v.21. How do we cooperate with God in our sanctification? How does the author point us to the source of our sanctification? How does the Lord's Supper communicate the two blessings of this benediction?
