Man's greatest problem:

is not in failure \_\_\_\_\_ God's righteous standards,

Romans 1:21-23

Because the natural man chooses to not acknowledge God...

The natural man's responses to the righteous standards of a holy God

- ▶ \_\_\_\_\_ as unreasonable, impractical, unethical
  - Set up our own standards and pick and choose which ones we keep
- ▶ \_\_\_\_\_
  - When we fail... overlook our failures and dismiss them as incidental.
  - When we fail... feel like failures and double our efforts, only to fail again.
  - When we fail... cry out for deliverance

**Justification:** an act of free grace by which God \_\_\_\_\_ the sinner and accepts him as \_\_\_\_\_, on account of the atonement of Christ.

A call to sanctification is only legitimate if the person has the capability to achieve it.
