1 Corinthians 6:9–11 (NKJV)

⁹ Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ¹⁰ nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. ¹¹ And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

Introduction:

November 10, 1969 was the first time the preschool television program, Sesame Street was aired on The Public Broadcasting System (PBS) That fall was my 1st year of school.

I can remember very vividly, the teacher turning on the TV and hearing that familiar theme song from Sesame Street. I can still hear it today. There was Big Bird, Burt and Ernie, Oscar the Grouch, who lived in the trash can, and of course my favorite, the cookie monster.

Judicial System is affected too.

Joseph Matthew Smith, a 23-year-old convicted of molesting a fellow MCS student in 2014, was “undergoing medical treatment that is needed prior to (Smith) potentially undergoing gender reassignment surgery.” Smith has received treatment for gender reassignment over the past two years at Newton Correctional Facility.

Smith has expressed a preference to identify as Josie, according to court documents.

The Church

“The truth is, being born with sinful dispositions affirms biblical doctrine. Everyone is a sinner by choice (Romans 1), but since Adam's Fall in Genesis 3, everyone is also a sinner by birth ([Romans 5:12](#)).

Those with a proclivity toward violence, theft, fornication, escapism, or homosexuality are not justified in violating God's law; sin is still sin. Same-sex attraction is not the same thing as homosexual thought patterns and practice. Even though we are

born with sinful desires, we still need redemption through Jesus Christ.”

Martin Luther call it “ a bent” we are all born with weaknesses and tendencies toward sin. We are all born sinners.

The other approach in the church now is what some call “Gay Christianity or Queer Christian”.

In the last couple of years we have witnessed the rise of a ministry called “Revoice”

I have read the statement of faith and found it orthodox, and I have read its statement on “Sexual Ethics and Christian Obedience”and found it to be an expression of Biblical fidelity with the exception of a theme that seems to run through the teaching.

It is stated clearly in the mission statement.

“To support and encourage gay, lesbian, bisexual, and other same-sex attracted Christians—as well as those who love them—so that all in the Church might be empowered to live in gospel unity while observing the historic Christian doctrine of marriage and sexuality.”

This seems to be a dominant ideology of the “gay christian” movement. It is that you always identify with your dominant sin.

1. The Clarification of Homosexuality

1. The Standard

Genesis 1:24–28 (NKJV)

²⁴ Then God said, “Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and

creeping thing and beast of the earth, *each* according to its kind”; and it was so. ²⁵ And God made the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth according to its kind. And God saw that *it was good*.

²⁶ Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” ²⁷ So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. ²⁸ Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

Genesis 2:21–25 (NKJV)

²¹ And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. ²² Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man.

19 Now the two angels came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw *them*, he rose to meet them, and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground.

² And he said, “Here now, my lords, please turn in to your servant’s house and spend the night, and wash your feet; then you may rise early and go on your way.”

And they said, “No, but we will spend the night in the open square.”

³ But he insisted strongly; so they turned in to him and entered his house. Then he made them a feast, and baked unleavened bread, and they ate.

⁴ Now before they lay down, the men of the city, the men of Sodom, both old and young, all the people from every quarter, surrounded the house.

⁵ And they called to Lot and said to him, “Where are the men who came to you tonight? Bring them out to us that we may know them *carnally*.”

⁶ So Lot went out to them through the doorway, shut the door behind him, ⁷ and said, “Please, my

brethren, do not do so wickedly! ⁸ See now, I have two daughters who have not known a man; please, let me bring them out to you, and you may do to them as you wish; only do nothing to these men, since this is the reason they have come under the shadow of my roof.”

⁹ And they said, “Stand back!” Then they said, “This one came in to stay *here*, and he keeps acting as a judge; now we will deal worse with you than with them.” So they pressed hard against the man Lot, and came near to break down the door. ¹⁰ But the men reached out their hands and pulled Lot into the house with them, and shut the door. ¹¹ And they struck the men who *were* at the doorway of the house with blindness, both small and great, so that they became weary *trying* to find the door.

Judges 19:22–25 (NKJV)

²² As they were enjoying themselves, suddenly certain men of the city, perverted men, surrounded the house *and* beat on the door. They spoke to the master of the house, the old man, saying, “Bring out the man who came to your house, that we may know him *carnally!*”

²³ But the man, the master of the house, went out to them and said to them, “No, my brethren! I beg

you, do not act so wickedly! Seeing this man has come into my house, do not commit this outrage. ²⁴ Look, *here is* my virgin daughter and *the man's* concubine; let me bring them out now. Humble them, and do with them as you please; but to this man do not do such a vile thing!" ²⁵ But the men would not heed him. So the man took his concubine and brought *her* out to them. And they knew her and abused her all night until morning; and when the day began to break, they let her go.

Romans 1:26–27 (NKJV)

²⁶ For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. ²⁷ Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.

Jude 6–7 (NKJV)

⁶ And the angels who did not keep their proper domain, but left their own abode, He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment of the great day; ⁷ as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the

2. The Prohibition of Homosexuality

1. Old Testament

Leviticus 18:21–25 (NKJV)

²¹ And you shall not let any of your descendants pass through *the fire* to Molech, nor shall you profane the name of your God: I *am* the Lord. ²² You shall not lie with a male as with a woman. It *is* an abomination. ²³ Nor shall you mate with any animal, to defile yourself with it. Nor shall any woman stand before an animal to mate with it. It *is* perversion.


²⁴ ‘Do not defile yourselves with any of these things; for by all these the nations are defiled, which I am casting out before you. ²⁵ For the land is defiled; therefore I visit the punishment of its iniquity upon it, and the land vomits out its inhabitants.

Leviticus 18:25–29 (NKJV)

²⁵ For the land is defiled; therefore I visit the punishment of its iniquity upon it, and the land vomits out its inhabitants. ²⁶ You shall therefore keep My statutes and My judgments, and shall not commit *any* of these abominations, *either* any of your own nation or any stranger who dwells among you ²⁷ (for all these abominations the men of the land have done, who *were* before you, and thus the land is defiled), ²⁸ lest the land vomit you out also when you defile it, as it vomited out the nations that *were* before you. ²⁹ For whoever commits any of these abominations, the persons who commit *them* shall be cut off from among their people.

2. New Testament

Romans 1:18–32 (NKJV)

¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, ¹⁹ because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown *it* to them. ²⁰ For since the creation of the world His invisible *attributes* are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, ²¹ because, although they knew God, they did not glorify *Him* as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened. ²² Professing to be wise, they became fools, ²³ and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four-footed animals and creeping things.

leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.

²⁸ And even as they did not like to retain God in *their* knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; ²⁹ being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; *they are* whisperers, ³⁰ backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, ³¹ undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful; ³² who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.

Becket Cook shares in the book “Change of Affections” how he went from being a successful Hollywood set designer with his identity rooted in his sexuality, to a sudden transformation through God. He was the youngest of 8 children, in a Christian family that believed that Homosexuality was a sin. After college, he gave himself over fully to the homosexual lifestyle and lived in the homosexuality for years.

But God had different plans for Becket. He was at a fashion week in Paris when he looked out over the large crowd and said to himself, “This can’t be what life is all about.” God began to work on his heart. Then in God’s providence, he was at a coffee shop with a friend and noticed that the people at the table next to them had bibles. He had never seen a bible out in public, especially in LA. So being prodded by his friend to stir up a conversation, he ask them if those where Bibles and were they Christians. After a few questions in general about what they believed he then asked a question as to what the church believed about homosexuality. They told him that they believed it was a sin, but

because of the emptiness he felt in Paris, he was open to going to the church.

So the next Sunday, he went and the Pastor was Preaching on Romans chapter 7. Beck, says everything the pastor was saying was resonating as true in his mind. He says he was literally on the edge of his seat listening to every word. At the end of the service, he says the Holy Spirit overwhelmed him and immediately he was convinced that God is real, Jesus is Gods Son, there is a Heaven and there is a Hell and Jesus died for sinners. He describes as a Paul on the Road to Damascus experience, or Isaiah 6 where Isaiah is becoming undone due to the Holiness of God and his sin. It was like the curtains had parted and he could finally see the truth. And he knew he had been adopted into the family of God. He just began to weep uncontrollably so much that people around him began to wonder if he was ok.

He says at that moment, he knew what the meaning of life was, and that being gay was not who he was and that that lifestyle was over!! He woke up every morning for a year overwhelmed with tears because of the love of God. He says he devoured the Bible, reading every word and believing every word. He began listening to hundreds and Hundreds of

sermons. He was and is consumed with Jesus Christ.
