SHIRLEY TITUS UPDATE: Shirley has been having a rough go of it again. After a good start to January, things quickly took a downward turn. She may be getting her molars which could be setting her off, but it could also just her genetic variant at work. It's not uncommon for these kids to go through intense waves of good and bad. She's been developing new types of seizure activity as well, which is alarming. Despite the struggle, she remains joyful. She teaches us what it looks like to suffer well.

We were able to start the process of getting an overnight nurse. We're waiting on her insurance to approve it. It will be a challenge logistically because of our current home situation. Typically, the nurses like to stay in the room with the child to best monitor them, but Shirley is in our bedroom and we only have one other bedroom. This is causing our need to find a home slightly more urgent than it had been. Pray that the Lord would lead us to a home within our budget that will meet Shirley's needs long term.
