Lamentations 2:11 Mine eyes do fail with tears, my bowels are troubled, my liver is poured upon the earth, for the destruction of the daughter of my people; because the children and the sucklings swoon in the streets of the city.

12 **They** say to their **mothers**, Where is corn **and** <u>wine</u>?...when their soul was poured out into their mothers' bosom.

Song of Solomon 5:1 I am come into my garden, my sister, my spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have **drunk my wine with my milk**: eat, O friends; drink, yea, **drink abundantly**, **O beloved.**

John 2:10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth **good wine**; and when men have **well drunk**, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.

Isaiah 1:22 Thy silver is become dross, thy wine mixed with water...

"*Must*, new **wine** - that first pressed out of the grape." (Blount, *Glossographia*, 1670)

"[Wine:]...a Liquor made of the Juice of Grapes, or other fruit." (John Kersey, A General English Dictionary, 1708)

"[Wine:] 1. the juice of the grape. 2. a liquor extracted from other fruits besides the

grape." (Benjamin Martin, *A New English Dictionary*, 1748)

"Until the close of the last century, nearly every Dictionary of Science included several species of unfermented wine under the head Wine." (John William Kirton, *The Temperance Hand-book*, 1874)

"[Wine:] The expressed juice of grapes, <u>esp.</u> when fermented..." (Webster's Revised Unabridged Dictionary, 1913)

Genesis 40:2 And Pharaoh was wroth against two of his officers, against the chief of the butlers, and against the chief of the bakers.

- 7 And he asked Pharaoh's officers that were with him in the ward of his lord's house, saying, Wherefore look ye so sadly to day?
- 9 And the chief butler told his dream to Joseph...
- 11 And Pharaoh's cup was in my hand: and I took **the grapes, and pressed them** into Pharaoh's **cup**, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.
- 13 Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and **thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner** when thou wast his butler.
- 21 And he restored the chief butler unto his butlership again; and **he gave the cup** into Pharaoh's hand:
- "'From this we find that *wine* anciently was the mere expressed juice of the grape, without fermentation."

- "...when he had strained **the wine**, he gave it to the king to drink...Thou sayest that thou didst squeeze **this wine** from three clusters of grapes with thine hands..." (Josephus, on Genesis 40)
- "...the kings of Egypt did not drink fermented wine till...long after the time of Joseph." (*The Church of England Temperance Magazine*, 1866)

"Wine and strong drink are a good, a blessing...and to be ranked with corn and oil. The same substances are also an evil. Their use is prohibited; and woe is denounced to all who seek for them. Is there a contradiction here...Not at all. We have seen that these substances were employed by the Hebrews in two different states; the one was a fermented state, the other an unfermented one...to me it seems plain - so plain that no wayfaring man need to mistake it...whenever the Scriptures speak of wine as a comfort, a

blessing...they mean...only such wine as contained no alcohol...wherein they denounce it, prohibit it, and connect it with drunkenness and reveling, they can mean only alcoholic or intoxicating wine..."

(Prof. Moses Stuart, 1800s)

Isaiah 24:9 They shall not drink wine with a song; **strong drink shall be bitter** to them...

Proverbs 23:31 Look not thou upon **the wine** when it is red, when it giveth his colour in the cup, when it moveth itself aright.

- 32 At the last it biteth like a serpent, and stingeth like an adder.
- 33 Thine eyes shall behold strange women, and thine heart shall utter perverse things.

Proverbs 20:1 Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.

1 Samuel 1:14 And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee.

15 And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I am a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have **drunk** neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.

16 Count not thine handmaid for a daughter of Belial...

2 Samuel 16:2 And the king said unto Ziba, What meanest thou by these? And Ziba said, The asses be for the king's household to ride on; and the bread and summer fruit for the young men to eat; and **the wine**, that **such as be faint in the wilderness may drink**.

"The notion so common in this country that unfermented wines will not keep, that they will soon ferment and spoil, is a most popular error grounded on ignorance..." (James B. Dunn, 1800s)

Dreams Are Often Insignificant Vanities:

Ecclesiastes 5:7 For in the multitude of dreams and many words there are also divers vanities: but fear thou God.

·1 <u>Dreams Can Be Terrifying, And Disturbing To Sleep</u>:

Daniel 2:1...Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.

·2 Yet, The *Deepest* Sleep Can Bring Dreams:

Job 33:15 In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men...

[Modern researchers define "deep" sleep, by how hard it is to wake a person up - which may, or may not agree with the Bible. God often classifies things differently than modern man. For God, a *fish* is generally something that swims in the water. Therefore, whale may be a fish! This is just one example among multitudes...Modern researchers say that REM is the part of sleep where the greatest restoration occurs. This is where they say most dreaming occurs - or, at least the dreams you may remember.]

·3 The Bible Speaks Of Sleep That Can Be Sweet:

Ecclesiastes 5:12 The sleep of a labouring man is sweet, whether he eat little or much: but the abundance of the rich will not suffer him to sleep.

· 4 <u>Dreams Can Therefore Be Very Pleasant</u>:

Psalms 126:1 When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were **like them** that dream.

2 Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing...
