## Mark 1:9–13 (ESV)

**9**In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.

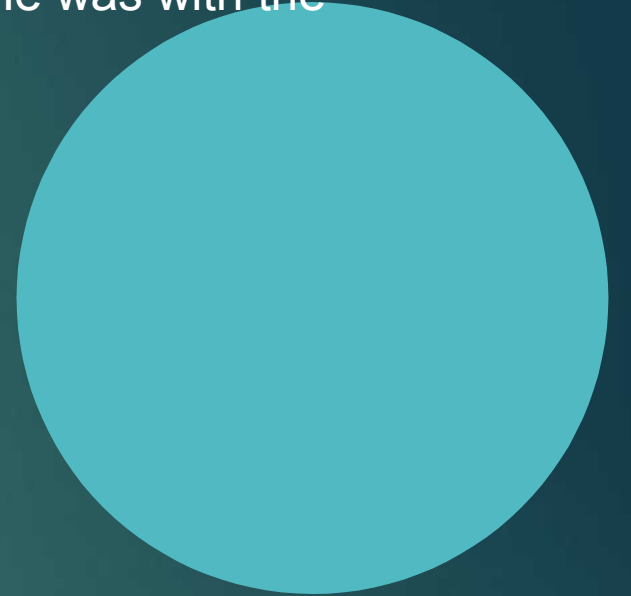
**10**And when He came up out of the water, immediately He saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on Him like a dove.

**12**The Spirit immediately drove Him out into the wilderness.

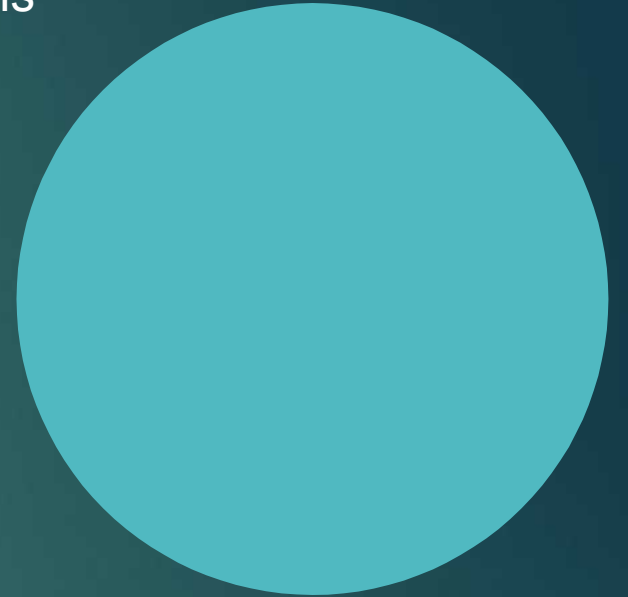
**13**And He was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. And He was with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to Him.



## Luke 12:49–50 (ESV)

**49**“I came to cast fire on the earth, and would that it were already kindled!

**50**I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how great is My distress until it is accomplished!”

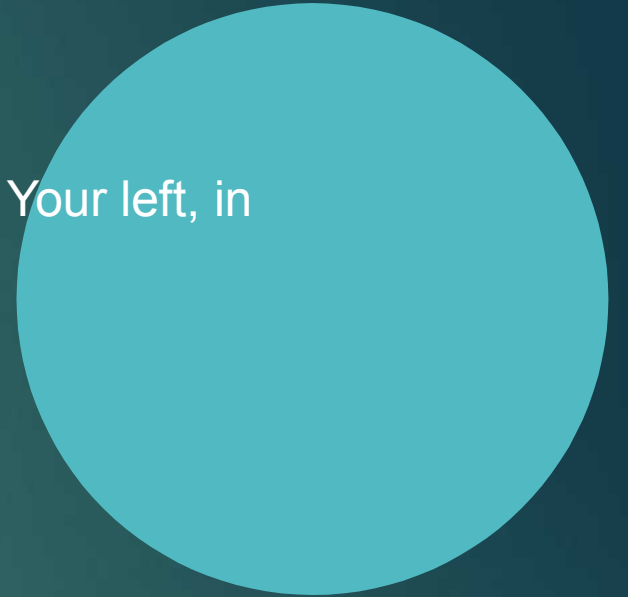


## Mark 10:35–40 (ESV)

**35** And James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came up to Him and said to Him, “Teacher, we want You to do for us whatever we ask of You.”

**36** And He said to them, “What do you want Me to do for you?”

**37** And they said to Him, “Grant us to sit, one at Your right hand and one at Your left, in your glory.”



## Mark 10:35–40 (ESV)

**38** Jesus said to them, “You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, or to be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?”

**39** And they said to Him, “We are able.” And Jesus said to them, “The cup that I drink you will drink, and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized,

**40** but to sit at My right hand or at My left is not Mine to grant, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared.”
