Luke 23:44-45

I John 1:5 *God is light.*

Gen. 1:3-4 *"Let there be light" ... the light was good*

Ex. 14:20 *the cloud ... gave light at night*

Matthew 2:2 *we saw His star in the east*

Luke 2:9 *the glory of the Lord shone around them*

Mark 9:3 *His clothes became radiant, intensely white*

Rev. 21:23 *no need of the sun or of the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp is the Lamb.*

I John 1:5 *in Him is no darkness at all.*

Psalms 18:28 says *You light my lamp; the LORD my God illumines my darkness.*

Psalms 107:10, 14 *There were those who dwelt in darkness ... He brought them out of the darkness.*

Isaiah 9:2 *The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; Those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them.*

Isaiah 59:9 *We hope for light, but behold, darkness, for brightness, but we walk in gloom.*

Job 30:26 *When I expected good, then evil came; when I waited for light, then darkness came.*

Job 29:2-5 *How I long for the months gone by, for the days when God watched over me, when his lamp shone upon my head and by his light I walked through darkness! Oh, for the days when I was in my prime, when God's intimate friendship blessed my house, when the Almighty was still with me and my children were around me...*

Acts 26:18 *turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God.*

Eph. 6:12 *Our struggle is ... against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.*

Romans 1:21 *their foolish heart was darkened*

I Peter 3:18 *Christ died for sins, the just for the unjust.*

I Peter 2:24 *He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross.*

I am the light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life. I have come as Light into the world, so that everyone who believes in Me will not remain in darkness. God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.
