1. The Pleasure of God in Judging Sin

(1) The completeness of the judgment

"Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him: He has put Him to grief"

v. 10

(2) The perfection of the judgment

"When You make His soul an offering for sin"

- the "assam" - the guilt or trespass offering

God is supremely glorified and pleased in the Person and Work of our Lord Jesus Christ!

(1) The Champion of Grace "Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong" 3. The Pleasure of God in Pouring out His Grace

(2) The Recipients of Grace

- "the great" "the strong"

AKA: "the transgressors"!!

(3) The Work of Grace: all of Christ! "Because He powed out His soul unto death, And the war unabsered with the transspecssors, And thence the size of framer, transspecssors," And made intercession for the transspecsors."

"He shall prolong His days"

Eternal life!

(3) The paradox of the judgment

Life out of death! "He shall see His seed"

- God's will prospers in this! "And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand"

(1) The pleasure of Jesus in justifying sinners

"He shall see the labor of His soul and be satisfied"
