Acts 13:40 Beware, therefore, lest what is said in the Prophets should come about: 41 " 'Look, you scoffers, be astounded and perish; for I am doing a work in your days, a work that you will not believe, even if one tells it to you.' " 42 As they went out, the people begged that these things might be told them the next Sabbath. 43 And after the meeting of the synagogue broke up, many Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who, as they spoke with them, urged them to continue in the grace of God. 44 The next Sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord. 45 But when the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and began to contradict what was spoken by Paul, reviling him.

4. Read Acts 11:21-23. What are some specific ways you were persuasively exhorted to remain faithful to the Lord when you were a new Christian?

5. Read Romans 12:17-19 and 1 Peter 2:23. What helpful strategies do you employ to maintain a biblical trust in God when you are tempted to retaliate in anger?
