Why is humble service in the local church (the body) so important?

- Because all things will **end** (4:7-11)
 - Think soberly (Heb 1:8-10)
 - Love fervently. (1 Pe 1:22; 1 Jn 3:16; James 2 :15)
 - Serve lovingly
 - **Speak** graciously (Eph 4:15; Col 4:6)
 - **<u>Do all</u>** spiritually
- Because all things <u>**need order**</u> (5:1-7)
 - Leaders lead willingly
 - Leaders lead **patiently**
 - Leaders lead personally
 - Leaders lead <u>humbly</u>
- Because all believers will be **<u>tested</u>**. (5:8-11)
 - o **<u>Ill-informed</u>** Christians are easy prey
 - o **Isolated** Christians are easy prey
 - o **<u>Immature</u>** Christians are easy prey
 - Growing Christians rely on God's **<u>Grace</u>** (2 Ti 2:1; 1 Co 15:58)
