- B. They are not Glorified Human Beings... Hebrews 2:16; 12:22

**Observation:** God is a spirit...angels are spirits...not as God is...only God is eternal...Psalm 104

- C. They are not Omniscient...
- 1. They know a lot... II Samuel 14:17
- 2. But not everything... Matthew 24:36 cf. I Peter 1:12 with Ephesians 3:10
- D. They are not Omnipotent...

They are powerful, Matthew 28:2; Acts 5:17-21; 12:10, but not all powerful...

- E. God's Eternal Purposes Pertain to them...
- 1. There are elect angels... I Timothy 5:21

2. There are fallen angels... Jude 6
