Discussion Questions

- 2. Are any of the traits in this passage true of you? What is the solution to the root of this problem?
- 3. While studying these 19 traits did you recognize that Satan is tempting you in any of these areas? (Such as loving self, loving money, ungratefulness, loving pleasure rather than God, etc.)
- 4. What should you be doing to resist the temptation?
- 5. What is the primary way you should be affected by this passage this week?
