- 3. Read **Acts 24:16** and **2 Corinthians 1:12**. In your own words, describe the experience of *not* possessing a "clear conscience" and what practical difference it makes when you do or don't have one?
- 4. Read **Titus 2:7-8** and **1 Peter 2:15**. What value does integrity have even in those situations when people persist in stubbornly opposing us because of our message and our alliance with Christ?
- 5. Read **2 Corinthians 6:14 7:1**. What things in your life come to mind when you read of the incongruous aspects of worldliness and godliness? How do the promises of familial closeness with God motivate you to take steps to "cleanse yourself" from those things?
