## Principles of Decision Making: The Way of Wisdom

- 1) Where there is no command, God gives us \_\_\_\_\_ (and responsibility) to choose.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ God and do whatever you please.

## Freedom of Decision Making

1. The nature of \_\_\_\_\_ law making requires that where there is no command, there is an assumed area of freedom
2. The nature of sin requires that where God gives \_\_\_\_\_ command, there is freedom.
3. The direct statements of \_\_\_\_\_ reveal that God gives freedom where He gives no command.
