**1**<sup>st</sup> – **THE INSTITUTION OF THE LOCAL CHURCH** (Para 5) – 'In the exercise of the authority which has been entrusted to Him, the Lord Jesus, through the ministry of the Word and by His Spirit, calls to Himself out of the world those who are given to Him by His Father, that they may live in His sight, rendering Him the obedience prescribed by Him for them in the Scripture. He commands those thus called to form particular societies or churches to promote their common welfare, and to engage in the public worship which He requires them to carry on while they continue in the world.' – Mt 18:15-20... 28:20...
