"Changeless"

A. Our God does NOT change!

- 1. Does not mean that God is "out of date", but fully contemporary!
- 2. God, in His essential being, does not change—Psalm 102
- 3. We change in three different ways:
 - a. From better to worse
 - b. From worse to better
 - c. From immaturity to maturity
- 4. God cannot change in the ways we do

B. Areas where God cannot change

- 1. God's Being does not change. Ps. 93:2; 1 Timothy 6:16
- 2. God's Character does not change—Exodus 34:5-8 (p. 101)
- 3. God's Purposes do not change—1 Samuel 15:28-29 (p. 329)
 - a. Saul and God's unchanging purposesb. Balaam's testimony to God's immutability—Num. 23:19
 - c. Our Salvation guaranteed by God's changelessness-Heb. 6
 - d. Passages where it appears that God changes His mind?
- 4. God's Word does not change—Isaiah 40:6-8; Psalm 119:89, 152
