Why does the Apostle Paul add this distinction here in his letter to the church?

- 1. Paul has an evangelistic zeal for Israel, his Jewish countrymen. Rom.9:1–6; 10:1–3
- 2. Paul also could have been concerned that his readers understand that not all Israelites should be respected and listened to as if they are part of the Israel of God.

Galatians 6:17 makes it clear that Paul wants his readers to be more discerning as to who they listen to.
