


Know the fact: Iife is full of trials and temptations (v.6).

Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations:





1.The believer's faith must be <u>tried.</u> <u>V.7a</u>



2. The believer's faith is <u>tried</u> in order <u>to show</u> forth the <u>praise</u>, <u>honor</u>, and <u>glory</u> of Jesus Christ and of the believer. V.7B

When Jesus Christ appears—when He returns to earth—

<u>2 things are going to be seen</u>.

1. Jesus Christ is going to be seen exalted higher than the heavens themselves; He is going to be seen in all the honor and glory of the universe.

2. Believers are going to be seen exalted higher than anyone could ever ask or even think; they are going to be exalted in the very same honor and glory of Christ Himself.


3. <u>Know how to conquer</u> trials and temptations (v.8-9).

1.First, we conquer them by our love for Christ. v.8



2.Trials and temptations are to be conquered by <u>our belief</u> in Jesus Christ. v.8




How do we overcome trials and temptations? 4 ways



Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.






