**TEXT: Psalm 147:5**

**TITLE: "God is INFINITE!" part 2**  
(Series: Attributes of God)

- Let's understand what infinite means and how God is INFINITE!
- Let's review the two categories of attributes: "Attributes of Greatness" and "Attributes of Goodness."

**1. WHAT IS MEANT BY "GOD IS INFINITE"?**

**A. Let's Understand the Word "Infinite"!**

- "Infinite" = "1. lacking limits or bounds; extending beyond measure or comprehension; without beginning or end; endless 2. very great; vast immense" (*WNWD*, p. 721).

**B. Let's Understand that God is Infinite!**

- **QUOTE:** "He is actually Infinite Being (not a series) and cannot be added to in any way" (Norman Geisler, *Systematic Theology*, 2:125).

- **QUOTE:** "By infinity we mean, not that the divine nature has no known limits or bounds, but that it has no limits or bounds. ... The infinity of God implies that he is in no way limited by the universe or confined to the universe; he is transcendent as well as immanent. Transcendence, however, must not be conceived as freedom from merely spatial restrictions, but rather as unlimited resource, of which God's glory is the expression."

"God himself is the only real Infinite, and the universe is but the finite expression or symbol of his greatness" (Augustus H. Strong, *Systematic Theology*, p. 254).

→ **THINK: How righteous God is and think on all He has done to deliver and save His people! More than can be counted!!**

**3. Believers Should S\_\_\_\_\_ of God's A\_\_\_\_\_ Continually ("all the day")— they will n\_\_\_\_\_ be exhausted!**

- Your Praise and Your Glory vs.8)
- Your righteousness and Your salvation (vs. 15)
- Your righteousness (vs. 24)

→ **QUOTE: Geneva Bible Notes:** "Because your benefits toward me are innumerable, I cannot but continually meditate and rehearse them."

**4. When O\_\_\_\_\_ Grows, We Rehearse God's Infinite Righteousness and Salvation—His Righteousness is Very High!!**

**6. We Press Forward in His S\_\_\_\_\_ Alone! (vs. 16), because there is none like He is (vs. 19c).**

**D. God is Infinite in His E\_\_\_\_\_/Being/Deep Things/Nature**
