## **Application Questions**

- 1. Read **Jeremiah 50:6-7** and **2 Peter 2:1-3**. How would you advise a Christian who says he doesn't really give much thought to who teaches him the Bible or who he follows spiritually, as long as they say they "love Jesus"?
- 2. Read **1 Corinthians 4:16**; **11:1** and **Philippians 3:17**. How do these verses challenge the popular refrain that we are all just "sinful beggars" who should always tell people to "look to Christ and not to us" because, after all, "Christians aren't perfect, just forgiven"? While there is, of course, some truth to those sentiments, why is this constant emphasis misleading and even harmful to the spiritual growth of God's people?
- 3. Read **Matthew 23:1-4**. Why would hypocrisy in our lives be a problem if what we are telling others is biblically accurate?
- 4. Read **Matthew 23:5-7**. How can you seek to avoid these twisted motives, especially in light of the instructions found in **Philippians 3:17** and **4:9**?
- 5. Read **1 Timothy 4:11-12**. What area of life listed in v.12 needs attention, knowing that you are continually setting an example for other Christians?
