The Heidelberg Catechism

22. Q. What, then, must a Christian believe?

A. All that is promised us in the gospel,[1] which the articles of our catholic and undoubted Christian faith teach us in a summary.

[1] Matt. 28:19; John 20:30, 31.

23. Q. What are these articles?

A. I. 1. *I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.*

II. 2. *I believe in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord;*

3. *He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary;*

4. *suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried;*
He descended into hell.

5. *On the third day He arose from the dead;*

6. *He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God the Father almighty;*

7. *from there He will come to judge the living and the dead.*

III. 8. *I believe in the Holy Spirit;*

9. *I believe a holy catholic Christian church, the communion of saints;*

10. *the forgiveness of sins;*

11. *the resurrection of the body;*

12. *and the life everlasting.*

30. Q. Do those believe in the only Savior Jesus who seek their salvation and well-being from saints, in themselves, or anywhere else?

A. No. Though they boast of Him in words, they in fact deny the only Savior Jesus.[1] For one of two things must be true: either Jesus is not a complete Savior, or those who by true faith accept this Savior must find in Him all that is necessary for their salvation.[2]

[1] I Cor. 1:12, 13; Gal. 5:4. [2] Col. 1:19, 20; 2:10; I John 1:7.

59. Q. But what does it help you now that you believe all this?

A. In Christ I am righteous before God and heir to life everlasting.[1]

[1] Hab. 2:4; John 3:36; Rom. 1:17; 5:1, 2.

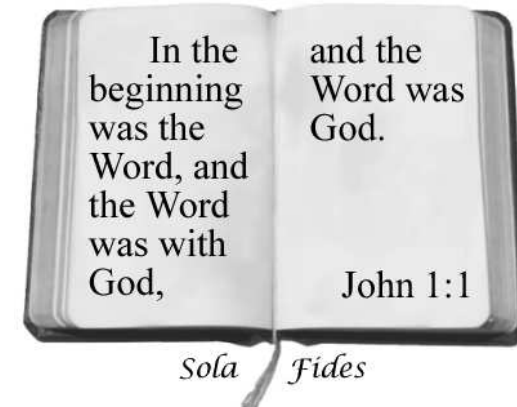
