- B. They had broken the <u>land covenant</u> seventy sevens times or 490 years worth. They received 70 years of exile for a land rest as a result
- C. Reading the prophetic <u>clock</u>: the time is near
- D. Humility, confession and praying the <u>promises</u> with faith
- E. The miraculous response of God: A heavenly visitor with a message from God
 - 1. 70 <u>sevens</u> are set by God for his people and the holy city (Jerusalem)
 - 2. It will accomplish some specific things
 - a. Finish the transgression
 - b. Make an end of sins
 - c. To make reconciliation for iniquity
 - d. To bring in everlasting righteousness
 - e. To seal up vision and prophecy
 - f. And to anoint the Most Holy
 - 3. It begins with the command to restore and build Jerusalem; the street and the wall will be built in troublesome times
 - 4. In 69 of those weeks Messiah will come and be "cut off" but not for Himself
 - 5. The people of the "prince" who is to come will destroy Jerusalem and the sanctuary and till the end of this war, desolations will continue
 - 6. The last week, the end of the war, will be initiated by the "prince"; the end of phase 2

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
