- I. God's Word: The Scriptures must be pre-eminent.
- II. God's Will: The sovereignty of God must be personalized
- III. God's Work: The salvation of sinners by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone for the glory of God alone must be proclaimed.
- IV. **God's Workmanship:** The **sanctification** that **prepares** us to reflect Christ is a work of God's on-going grace.

- I. God's Word: The Scriptures must be pre-eminent.
 - A. The Scriptures are pre-eminent when we <u>choose</u> to **PRIZE** them through **personal study**.
 - 1. Jeremiah 15:16
 - 2. Psalm 119:111
 - 3. II Timothy 2:15
 - B. The Scriptures are pre-eminent when we choose to PREACH them, and <u>not paraphrase</u> them to justify a a carnal life-style. II Timothy 4:1-4

- C. The Scriptures are pre-eminent when we choose to **PRACTICE** them.
 - 1. Ralph Waldo Emerson, wrote, "Your actions speak so loudly that I cannot hear what you say."
 - 2. James 1:22 "Be **doers** of the Word...."
 - 3. I John 3:7 "He who **practices** righteousness...."
 - 4. The **imputed** righteousness of Christ must be reflected in the **practical** righteousness of living out the gospel.

II. God's Will: The **sovereignty** of God must be **personalized**.

- A. God is sovereign over the time of **your birth** and **your death**.
 - 1. Job 14:5 "...You have appointed his limits...."
 - 2. Psalm 139:16 "...the days fashioned for me...."
- B. God is sovereign over **your salvation**.
 - 1. John 17:1-2 "...as many as You have given Him...."
 - 2. John 10:26-29 He gives eternal life to His sheep.
 - 3. Study for yourself Ephesians 1 and 2; Romans 8

- C. God is sovereign over the **details of your life**.
 - 1. Your **personal** characteristics. Exodus 4:10-11
 - 2. Your pathway in life. Psalm 37:23-24
 - 3. Your **plans**: Proverbs 19:21

- D. God is sovereign over **your trials**.
 - 1. I Peter 4:19
 - 2. Philippians 1:29
 - 3. I Peter 2:20-21 He is our Example

If we merely endure suffering without seeing it as **God's instrument** to **demonstrate the reality** of our faith, to **develop the resolve** of our faith and to **delight in the rewards** our faith, we will not become more like Christ.
