Introduction: The first person I ever led to Christ. We have been in a short Series on Stewardship. We turn to the book of Acts as we address the Stewardship of the Gospel

I. A Look at The Author's Preface

- A. Still same purpose as the Gospel of Luke. Luke 1:1-4
- B. Acts is Unique in NT compare to the Gospels and Letters
 - Gospels show power of Christ's sinless life, death, resurrection.
 - Acts show the power of the Ascended One!
 - Epistles show what the church is to be
 - Acts shows how the church came to be

(Revelation shows what the church is to become.)

- C. Luke's Introduction Acts 1:1-4
 - It was 40 days between His resurrection and ascension.
 - Luke closed with the ascension. Acts begins just prior to it.
- D. The promise of the Spirit led to speculation on part of the disciples. The Kingdom will not be returned to Israel, but spread over the whole world!

Resurrection Transformed the disciples. Fearful, broken, discouraged – to joyful, expectant Pouring out of Spirit would transform them yet again – in Power to fulfill the promises of God!

- II. CHRIST'S ENDURING MISSION Bringing Glory to the Father! What Has Jesus Begun to do and teach? (v.1)
 - A. His finished work?
 - 1. His death on the cross, bearing the wrath of God, rejected by the Father. NOTE: His Low Point Our Starting Point.
 - 2. He Glorified God. John 17:1-8 NOTE: "Make your name known" harkens back to Exodus 3:13-15. It reveals who God is in his character and in his nature. Psalms 22:22; Isaiah 52:6; Ezekiel 39:7
 - God put his *name* in the tabernacle/temple in the midst of His people Deut.12:5
 - Jesus has become the "place" where God has placed His name! (cf. John 2:19; Phil.2:9-11)
 - B. His ongoing work includes:
 - 1. God bringing salvation/life John 5:24; 6:47
 - 2. Luke 4:18,19 Christ's Calling Isaiah
 - 3. Calling people to Himself
 - 4. His reign in the resurrection!
 - 5. Seeking worshippers who worship in spirit and truth John 4:21-24 *They Will Make His Name Known!!*

- III. CHRIST'S EXTENDED MISSION Revealing His Glory to the Ends of the Earth! In Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, the end(s) of the earth
 - A He is still doing everything He began!
 - B. Gathering the people of God!
 - Israel was a community who worshipped the living God.
 - Christ renews/restores the worshipping community.
 - How?
 - C. "You will be my witnesses." He is extending the mission/work through us!! v.8 key to Acts, key to God's promise and plan
 - "To the ends of the earth." Did the Apostles get to the ends of the earth? No, But they passed on the message to other witnesses who have!
- **IV. CHRIST'S ENTRUSTED MISSION** Bringing Glory to the Father and the Son. "*You will be my witnesses*". What would move us to such Witness??
 - A. Obedience! The savior, the Lord and King of Creation our redeemer and the lover of our souls has commanded it. Surely we will obey. Matthew 28:20 Go!! Acts 1:8 -You will be my witnesses!
 - B. Love for the Lost; Compassion.
 - We are spiritual beings; cannot live on bread alone.
 - We cannot obey the command to love our neighbors if we leave them to starve without any knowledge or witness to the bread of life/of heaven.
 - C. For the Sake of His Name! Maybe our strongest drive comes from a desire for the honor and glory of God the be revealed from
 - 1. A Love for His Name! Romans 1:5; 3 John 7
 - 2. To what Name do we testify to "the ends of the earth?" Isaiah 45:21; Philippians 2:9
 - 3. Worship *produces* Witness(es). They are bound together in or by the glory, beauty, power of His name!
 - a. Worship is to delight in and lift up His Name to exalt the King of Kings!
 - b. To witness is to call others to delight in that name, to worship and to magnify the Lord with us!
 - 4. Witness leads to worship
 - John 4:23 "Yet a time is coming *and has now come* when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks."

Our worship of the Living God must break forth in witness! Has yours??
