Noah and the Flood – Part 1 Genesis 6:9-22 February 7, 2016

Main Point:

Like Noah, Jesus obeyed God's plan of salvation; since He did it for you, live in the same kind of obedience today, as a righteous person should.

1. Noah was a righteous man who lived in an unrighteous world.

2. As a righteous man, Noah was obedient to God's plan of salvation.

3. Noah's obedience was specific, difficult, and expensive.

4. Noah is a picture of Jesus Christ who did the same for your salvation.

5. Live in the same kind of obedience, as a righteous person should.

J.G. Vos "The statement that Noah was a just and perfect man ... does not mean that Noah was sinless. It means that he was a godly man who lived a consistent life."
