- I. The business that brings blessings. (Psalms 126:6)
 - A. "He that goeth forth...." (Luke 14:23; John 9:4)
 - B. "and weepeth..." (Luke 19:41)
 - C. "bearing precious seed...." (1 Peter 1:23; Mark 4:3-20; 4:1)
 - D. "Shall doubtless come again with rejoicing..."

- II. Lessons from the man who brought his brother to Jesus. (John 1:35-42)
 - A. Andrew thought of his brother.
 - B. After he thought of his brother, Andrew sought him.
(John 1:40-42; Acts 8:5; John 1:41-42)

- III. Bible examples in how to win others to Christ. (Proverbs 11:30)
 - A. Andrew teaches us how to win others by our love. (2 Corinthians 5:14)
 - B. Phillip teaches us to witness to and win the lost by obedience. (Acts 8:27-40)
 - C. Peter teaches us to witness with confidence in the Holy Spirit. (Acts 10:1-48; 10:20)
 - D. Paul teaches us how to win other by continuance. (Acts 26:22)

- IV. Three simple steps to winning someone to Christ before the year is over! (Acts 8:4-8, 26-40)
 - A. Phillip was a willing worker. (Acts 8:26,27)
 - B. Phillip trusted the witnessing Spirit to lead him. (Zechariah 4:6)
 - C. Phillip had a working knowledge of the scripture. (Acts 8:35)
 - D. You will need to know the following steps and scriptures in order to lead someone to Christ.
 1. Romans 3:10, 23 – We are all sinners.
 2. Romans 6:23 – The wages of sin.
 3. Romans 5:8 – Jesus died to pay the sin debt.
John 1:12; Romans 6:23 – Christ died for all of us.
 4. The fourth step is to show how a decision to trust Christ is made.
(Romans 10:9-13, 13; Hebrews 7:25)
 5. Draw in the net.
 6. Teach the truth of assurance to everyone you lead to Christ. (Romans 8:38,39)
 7. Remember to do your duty after you have led someone to the Lord.
