## The God in whom believers take refuge (1)

- He is your sovereign
- He is your dwelling place
- He is unchangingly the dwelling place for all of God's people

## The reasons you ought to take refuge in God (2-6)

- Because He is eternal (2)
- Because He rules over the timing of your death (3)
- Take refuge in Him because He is very different than you (4-6)
  - He is above time, you are in and bound by time (4)
  - He is the sovereign and immortal God, you are out of control and transient in your mortality (5-6)

## The explanation of our transience, the existence of death, and the resulting need to take refuge in God (7-10)
