 - b. FOLLOW THE WAYS OF THE LORD
 - i. The Nations did all the abominations (becoming unclean)
 - ii. Making the land unclean
 - iii. If you do the same, the land will “vomit” you out
 - iv. JUST as the land “vomited” them out
 - c. **If a person does them (the abominations), he shall die by them. (v. 29)**
 - i. (Meant to recall verse 5, “If a person does them, he shall live by them.”)
