A. What is "Grace"?

- 1. Scriptural Support of the "God of Grace"-- Ps 103:8; 116:5-6; John 1:14
- 2. Scriptural Definition of Grace-- 2 Corinthians 8:9; Hebrews 4:16
 - -- "God giving what we do not deserve"
 - -- "God's help in our time of need"

B. When do we need God's Grace?

- 1. God's Grace and **Salvation**!
 - a. Our condition before God's help arrives—Eph. 2:1-3
 - b. God's help arrives in the person of Jesus Christ
 - c. You and I have been saved by God's grace through faith.
 - 1) Salvation is solely by God's grace!
 - 2) Not by human effort—no "co-pay" plan
- 2. God's Grace and Suffering-- 2 Cor. 12:9
- 3. God's Grace and Service-- 1 Cor. 15:10

C. How do we receive God's Grace?

- 1. We must humble ourselves-- Prov. 3:34; James 4:6
- 2. We must ask Him for help.—Heb. 4:16
- 3. We must accept help from others-- 1 Peter 4:10
