- raised in an idol worshipping home
- he listened to one who claimed to have direct revelations from God - *but he gave advice contrary to God's clear Word*

- **No one knows of one time he had personal devotions or was active in public worship**
- **he habitually acted contrary to God's Word**
- **he was always looking out for himself**

- **He preferred the company of the ungodly rather than God's people**
- **Every attempt by God to get him away from the ungodly he resisted**

***So, is this man a

- ***In a drunk state he was
physically intimate with
his 2 daughters & both
got pregnant***

Genesis
19: 17-22,
30-32, 36



GOD'S COMMENTARY ON LOT:

2 Pet. 2: 6-8

- ***“just”*** = righteous (v.8)
- **Gen.18:23 - *“Will You destroy the righteous with the wicked?”***

place*

**#2 - Lot Watched Worship
But Never DID It**

Gen. 12:6-8; 13:1-4

ADVICE FROM GENESIS:

If you're ever in the wrong place & out of the will of God, either by innocence or by choice, the only cure is to build altars and draw near to God

#4 - Lot Failed Because He Chose Things Over God

Gen.12:14 - 13:10 -

***Lot may have left Egypt,
but Egypt never . . .***

Gen. 19:18,19

Lot **KNEW** he was being shown great mercy, but he still wanted Sodom and the earthly pleasures and the stuff it offered.

1. Gave him two godly examples

2. Gave wealth, took it, then returned it

**3. Gave him a powerful,
praying friend**

**4. Gave him a personal
warning by angels**

**5. Gave him a personal
picture of how sin is
judged**
