The Last Sacrifice

Psalm 40:6-8; John 14:1-6; Hebrews 9:23-10:20

I. THE PHYSICAL BODY OF CHRIST

- A. Importance of Physical Reality (Jn 1:14; 1 Jn 1:1 & 4:2-3)
 - 1. The <u>Objective Reality</u> of Creation (Gen 1:1; Rom 8:19-22)
 - a. <u>Value</u> of the Material World (Gen 1:1)—God's good creation

b. <u>Authority</u> of the Creator God (Gen 1:27 & 3:5; Ps 100:3)—God owns His creation

2. The <u>Actual Physicality</u> of Christ (1 Jn 4:2-3)

a. Necessity for <u>Atonement</u> (Heb 9:22 & 10:10; Rom 8:3;)—real, physical blood was required

b. Reality of the <u>**Resurrection**</u> (Ps 16:10; Act 3:15 & 10:39-41 & 26:23; Rom 8:11; 1 Cor 15:4)—our hope is not *escape from* the body but resurrection and glorification *of* the physical body

B. <u>Doing the Will of God</u> (10:4-7; Ps 40:6-8)—in the body

1. The <u>Plan</u> of God (9:26 & 10:10; Ps 40:7; Rev 5:6-10 & 13:8)— Jesus Christ is the executor of God's plan for Redemptive History.

2. The <u>Work</u> of God (Gen 1:28; 1 Sam 15:22 : Mic 6:6-8)—perfect obedience; doing what Adam and Israel failed to do

II. THE SUBSTITUTIONARY ATONEMENT OF CHRIST

A. <u>The Great Exchange</u> (Rom 6:23; 1 Pet 2:24 & 3:18)—trading places

1. <u>**Our Sinfulness</u> Credited to Jesus** (Isa 53)—He took the punishment that *we earned* by our sin.</u>

2. <u>Jesus' Righteousness</u> Credited to Us (Jer 23:6; Rom 3:21-22)— We receive the reward *He earned* by His perfect obedience.

B. <u>The Great Salvation</u> (10:10, 14)—being and becoming

1. <u>Justification</u> (Jn 10:28; Rom 3:23-25; 1 Cor 6:20; Col 1:21-22)— declared holy; once for all made acceptable and restored to God

2. <u>Sanctification</u> (Phil 1:6 & 2:12-13)—process of transformation; *becoming* holy; growing in grace

III. THE FINISHED WORK OF CHRIST (10:10-20)

A. <u>He is Seated</u>. (9:25-26, 28; 10:11-14)

1. The sacrifice was <u>once for all time</u>. (9:26-28; 10:12)— full atonement for all time was completed on the cross.

- a. Paid in Full (Jn 19:30)—It is finished
- b. <u>Cannot be Repeated</u> (10:9-10, 18)—not possible or necessary
- 2. We have Complete Redemption. (Heb 7:25; 9:12, 15)
 - a. <u>Comprehensive</u> (7:25)—all-encompassing
 - **b.** <u>Eternal</u> (9:12, 15)—permanent, never expires
- B. <u>He is the New and Living Way</u>. (10:19-20; Jn 14:6; Mat 27:51)
- C. <u>He is Returning</u>. (9:28; Jn 14:1-6)
