unless you believed in vain.

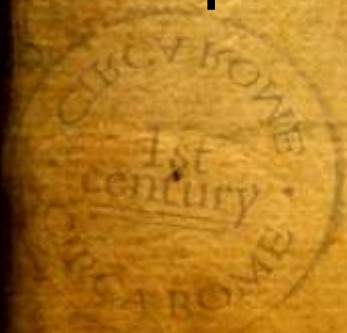
