Biblical Principles of Evangelism Acts 8:26-40

Main Point:

Having been called to witness for Jesus, remember the Bible's principles of evangelism.

- 1. Your efforts are essential.
- 2. Don't underestimate the importance of ministering to only one person.
- 3. The issue is sin and the goal is reconciliation.
- 4. People need to be taught from the Bible if they are to believe.
- 5. The sufferings of Christ are the only grounds for salvation.
- 6. Faith and baptism are the right responses.
