- 5. What are some ways you have shown favoritism, even unintentionally, to those in your circle of influence? How have you seen favoritism practiced in your church?
- 6. How should Christ's judgment on the last day affect your words and actions today? Does this contradict God's grace? How would you explain your answer.
- 7. Why does showing mercy depend on receiving mercy, and how does the message of the gospel fit into this?
- 8. How does care for the poor in our communities and around the world affect our gospel witness?
