Matthew 5:9b "... For they shall be **called** the children of God."

IV. THE ULTIMATE BENEFIT

'children' = Greek *huioi*, not *tekna Tekna* = tender affection *Huioi* = dignity, honor, **character**

What makes this benefit ultimately sublime?

Oh! to be like Thee, oh! to be like Thee, Blessed Redeemer, pure as Thou art; Come in Thy sweetness, come in Thy fullness; Stamp Thine own image deep on my heart.
