Luke 7:1-10; Hebrews 13:17

I. Five biblical truths about leaders

- A. Submit? Says who! (submission to parents Luke 2:51; Exodus 20:12; Ephesians 6:1-3; to government Romans 13:1-5; Titus 3:1; 1 Peter 2:13ff.; wives to their husbands 1 Corinthians 14:34; Ephesians 5:24; Colossians 3:18; Titus 2:5; 1 Peter 3:1-5; to God himself Hebrews 12:9; James 4:7; Christ to God the Father 1 Corinthians 15:28; all things to Christ 1 Corinthians 15:27-28; Ephesians 1:22; 5:24; Philippians 3:21; Hebrews 2:5-8; to leaders among God's people Numbers 15; Philippians 2:14-16; 1 Corinthians 16:15; 1 Peter 5:5)
- B. Leaders really are appointed by God (Numbers 15)
- C. Leaders should be given a willing and careful hearing (Hebrews 13:17; Acts 17:11; see also Psalm 37:7; 62:1; Haggai 2:18)
- D. Leaders should simply be obeyed when doing so would not be rebellion against God (Hebrews 13:17)
- E. Leaders are in authority because they are under authority (Luke 7:1-10)
- F. Leaders are in a vulnerable position as those who give account to their Lord (Luke 12:41-48; Hebrews 13:17; James 3:1; Ezekiel 34:10)
