4. Confession

Ezra 10:10-11 – Ezra counseled the people – You have been unfaithful and added to the guilt of Israel. Now therefore, make confession to the Lord God... and do His will.

Neh 9:2 – The people of Israel separated themselves from their sin, and stood and confessed their sins and the iniquities of their fathers.
