- Pseudo-Christians live with false assurances of salvation (Matt. 7:21-23)
 - a) Simply knowing that Jesus is "Lord" (Mark 1:24; Jas. 2:19)
 - b) Being passionate and zealous for Christ (2 Kings 10:16)
 - c) Proclaiming truth in God's name (e.g., Balaam, Saul)
 - i) Some preach out of envy (Phil 1:15)
 - ii) Paul feared being disqualified (1 Cor 9:27)
 - iii) Love for Christ is the key (1 Cor 13:1-3)
 - d) Ability to exorcise demons (Judas, sons of Sceva)
 - e) Performing mighty deeds for God (Matt 24:24; 2 Thess 2:8)
 - i) Satan transforms himself (2 Cor 11:14)
 - ii) Power makes us arrogant (Luke 10:20)
