1. The house he had built (4b)
2. The food on the table (5a)
3. The seating of his servants (5)
4. The attendance of his waiters and their attire (5)
5. The cupbearers tasted for poison.
6. The stairway that went up to the Temple. (5)

The other Son of David...

How is His table arranged?

1. He is the Temple. (Jn 2.19; Rev 21.22)
2. The food He sets before us is His own Body and Blood. (Matt 26.26-28)
3. The seating of His servants are not those seated at Solomon's table.
4. His attendants are clothed in the Armor of God. (Eph 6.13-17)
5. He is our Cupbearer. (Jn 18.11)
6. His Staircase (Jn 1.51; Rev 19.11-16)
