Gentlemen,

1. Patience is a hallmark of maturity. Saul lacked patience in chapter 13. As leaders our impatience can affect many others. Is this an issue with you? Where and when do you tend to be impatient and why is this a reality. If you have overcome this issue what was the key factor in the change? Share that with another if appropriate.
2. As a king Saul sought to fulfill the duties of a prophet. It did not profit him in any way. Are you or have you ever been “mis-employed”. Do you have a tendency to take on roles that are not for you and miss opportunities to thrive in your “lane”? Are you a point guard trying to be a center? Why is that? What are you looking for when you attempt something you are not to do? Why not say no?
3. Saul was somewhat of a people pleaser. He was more concerned with his men’s opinions than God’s facts? Is this you on some level? Are you ashamed of the gospel? (Romans 1:16). Are you overly influenced by the wants, opinions and desires of others? If so, why empower others to run your life?
4. What is it that you want? Are you counting on others to provide you with it or are you sharing that process with Christ?
5. What is it that you no longer want? What are you going to do about it, today?
