- What does Paul clarify to the Jews about themselves in regards to circumcision, the Law and their status before God as Jews (25-27)?
- What would the Jew conclude about himself in regards to his righteousness, his peril of judgment, and his need for a savior based on this entire passage especially verses 28-29?

"For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh. But he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that which is of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter; and his praise is not from men, but from God." Romans 2:28-29 (NASB)
