CHRIST TASTED DEATH FOR EVERY MAN

Adam could not do it. The Lord Jesus Christ came in order to do it—to have the subjection. *But*, in contradiction to the other several verses, *we see Jesus*. Who was He? Perfect God and perfect Man. Why did He come? To save sinners—all of us. He came into the world.
