- What two types of people does Paul speak of (5)?
- What are the two ways of living contrasted in this section (6-7)?
- How does our present identity calm our fears about the coming judgment (4)?
- What does it mean to focus on being awake and sober while we wait for the Lord?

Certain of our ultimate destiny (8-11)

1 Thess 1:10; Rom 6:3-6; 8:9-11; 14:9; Rom 13:12-14; Eph 6:11-12; Isa 59:17

- How does our ultimate destiny calm our fears about the coming judgment (9-10)?
- How does the armor help us as we wait for the Lord (8)?
- How do the commands about one another shape how we wait for the Lord (11)?
- In what ways are we tempted to fear or lose focus while we wait for Christ's coming and how does this passage address those issues?
