The Verdict Acts 26:30-32

Introduction

The pronouncement of a verdict is a tense time.

It is a verdict on various levels: accused, advocate, jury.

Paul was not on trial, yet there were many verdicts

I. The Gospel comes to you from those the world declares innocent.

- A. Paul and Christ have given you the Gospel in purity. [1Pe. 2:21]
 - 1. Paul was recognized as innocent of all charges. [31-32]
 - 2. Christ was recognized as innocent of charges. [Luke 23:14-15]
- B. They have no ulterior motive in giving you the Gospel.
 - 1. They are pure in heart.
 - 2. They suffered to give you the Gospel.
- C. Receive the Gospel as a gift of God's goodness to you.
 - 1. What God offers you is not shady, but pure and holy.
 - 2. The free gift is truly free unlike 'no free lunch.'

II. Don't be distracted by the chains the world puts on God's people.

- A. Both Christ & Paul were led from their hearings in bonds.
 - 1. The world will bind you to please the people as with Christ.
 - 2. The world may test your underhandedness as with Paul.
- B. It is often by the world's bonds that you accomplish God's purpose.
 - 1. By the bonds of Christ your salvation was won.
 - 2. By the bonds of Paul the Gospel was spread.
- C. Chains may be a badge of honor for God's people.
 - 1. Sabina Wurmbrand: Wipe the shame from Christ's face.
 - 2. By suffering for Christ you are living out your union with Him.

III. Don't walk away from the Gospel unchanged.

- A. God has given you the good news of His grace.
 - 1. You are not saved by your works, otherwise grace is not grace.
 - 2. In repentance and faith you will have eternal life.
- B. Your position in life is never so high as to not need God's grace.
 - 1. Don't walk away now; this call may never come to you again.
 - 2. Paul & Christ's Gospel demands a verdict from you!
 - 3. Not to decide is to decide.
- C. Christ invites you to come to Him for His grace. [Matt. 11:28-30]
 - 1. Cast your burden on Him who wills to care for you!
 - 2. He buries your burden at the cross.

Conclusion

Your verdict on the Gospel will declare God's verdict on you.

God, the holy & righteous one, is the eternal Judge.

Wickedness surrounds you! Jesus gives you righteousness.
