"I gathered all the information I could on the subject...and was soon informed that there was a peculiar process by which the devil might be raised and become personally visible. I then placed myself in the center of the circle, and either said or read the Lord's Prayer backwards. This I accomplished at first with some trepidation and in great fear towards the close of the scene. I then stood still in the center of that magic and superstitious circle, looking with intense anxiety in all directions, especially at the window and at the chimney...My uninstructed faculties led me from doubts of the existence of a devil to doubts of the book and the religion which asserted him to be a living being."

If they heard of a phantom, these spiritual detectives speedily put themselves in pursuit..."
