- B. NEGATIVE: HOSTILE, MALICIOUS; REBELLIOUS** (*tempt, test*; Mk.12:13(15); Mt.22:15(18); Lk.20:20; Jn.8:6)
- C. SIGNIFICANCE: UN/BELIEF, DIS/OBEDIENCE** (Ps.78:17-22; 41f; 56f; 70 / Mal.3:10; Is.7:11f)
- D. SUMMARY: “TRYING/VERY TRYING”**

II. TESTING JESUS (Mt.16:1-4 (12:38,39); Mk.8:11-13; Lk.11:16,29; 12:54-56)

- A. TESTING GOD IS WICKED & UNFAITHFUL** (Mt.16:1,4 (12:38,39); Lk.11:16,29; see Mk.8:11,12)
- B. OPEN EYES FOR SKY SIGNS** (Mt.16:2,3; Lk.12:54-56)
- C. CLOSE EYES FOR HEAVENLY SIGNS** (Mt.16:2,3; Lk.12:54-56; see Mt.13:14-16)

- D. USE THE MEANS OF GRACE TO RESIST BEING TEMPTED!** (Acts 2:42; see Lk.4:1-13 & 20:40,46; see 1Cor.11:24f; Eph.4:14f)
- E. USE THE MEANS OF GRACE TO RESIST TESTING GOD!** (Acts 2:42; see Mt.16:1&4; see 11:5; see Num.14:22; Ps.78:7,11; Dt.6:4f,12,16; see Rom.1:21f; 1Cor.11:24f; Eph.4:14f)
