## What Does it Mean That God is Invisible?

God cannot be seen:
John 1:18
Exodus 33:20
1 Timothy 6:15–16
1 John 4:12

Why?

But what about these verses: Genesis 16:13 Exodus 24:10 Isaiah 6:5 We all believe with the heart and confess with the mouth that there is only one God, who is a simple and spiritual Being; He is eternal, incomprehensible, **invisible**, immutable, infinite, almighty, perfectly wise, just, good, and the overflowing fountain of all good.—Belgic Confession, art. 1

Q. What is God?
A. God is a Spirit, in and of himself infinite in being, glory, blessedness, and perfection; all-sufficient, eternal, unchangeable, incomprehensible, everywhere present, almighty, knowing all things, most wise, most holy, most just, most merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth.—Westminster Larger Catechism, Q&A 7
