vv. 12-13

(1) The Corruption that was commonplace

"Then Jesus went into the temple and drove out all those who bought and sold..."

- (2) Jesus' Action
 - The second time recorded in the gospels cf. Jn
 - Jesus is angry and properly so!
- (3) Jesus' Charge

"It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you have made it a den of thieves!"

- Is. 56:7
- "a house of prayer" = a place of worship
- "a den of thieves" = a center of corruption

2. Jesus Heals the Blind and Lame

v. 14

(1) He drives out the "profiteers" and welcomes to Himself the afflicted.

"Then the blind and lame came into the temple, and He healed them."

- (2) The True High Priest heals a fallen and maimed humanity!
- 3. Jesus Receives the Praise of His Covenant Children

vv. 15-16

(1) The children are praising Jesus!

"crying out in the temple...
'Hosanna to the Son of David!"

(2) The Chief Priests and Scribes indignant!

"they were indignant and said to Him,
"Do you hear what these are saying?""

- (3) The Rebuke of the King
 - -1- The children's praise reminded Jesus of Psalm 8
 - -2- He indicates that the appropriateness of the children's praise should be quite obvious!
 - God esteems the voices of children among the most excellent things of His creation!

"Yes. Have you never read,
'Out of the mouth of babes
and nursing infants
You have perfected praise'?"

- This chorus of praise is superior to that "chorus" of sun, moon, and stars!
- Jesus says to His enemies, "Would you dare silence this chorus?"
