INTRODUCTION

- 1. Being loved is humbling. We want to be loved & to love.
- 2. 2C5:13-15 Christ's love for us: v15; Rm 8:34-35; 1Jn 4:9-10
- 3. Christ's love gripped & motivated Paul

1st: A Life of Union with Jesus' Death and Resurrection - v14b-15a

- 1. *therefore all died... that they who live*: joined to Jesus' death & resurrection.
- 2. Rm 6:11-13
 - i. v1-10 define us: united in Jesus' death & res in rln to $\sin v10-11$.
 - ii. Imperatives [commands] are based on indicatives [factual statements]: b/c we are united to Christ, we are commanded to live for Christ v13b

2nd: A Life of Discipleship

- 1. <u>2C5:15b</u> they who live [united to Jesus in His resurrection] no longer live for self [having died w/ Jesus in His death]. No longer living for self.
 - i. interpersonal communication dynamics
 - ii. technology
- 2. In Gn 3 desire for autonomy: selfish selfolatry is idolatry
- 3. *no longer live for self* = essence of discipleship Lk 9:23.
- 4. We have died to sin of selfishness united to Jesus' death.

3rd: A Life of Service

- 1. <u>2C5:13</u> *for God, for you*. Serve Jesus by serving His Bride Mt 25:40.
- 2. We are alive to live & serve united to Jesus' resurrection Gal 6:10
- **3**. Best way to break back of selfishness is to serve others out of love for Jesus.
