A Different Jesus

Efforts to reinvent, reimagine, repackage Jesus are all blasphemy. They are attempts to remake the Lord in an image other than that which we find in the Bible. Whether the motive is it to write Him off as myth, render Him insignificant, make Him out to be ridiculous, or even to make him less offensive and more palatable to the tastes of worldly mindedness, it is wicked. Rarely will anyone question the historicity of the person of Jesus, but many have, do and will continue to distort Who He really is by taking away from what the Bible clearly says about Him, or adding things that the Bible does not say about Him. The fundamental problem for such unbelievers is of course unbelief! The problem they have with the real Jesus is that His person demands a response of repentance, belief, and surrender. The consequences of rejecting Jesus are bad enough, but those who make Him into something He is not, and convincing others that Jesus is anyone other than He to whom the Word of God attests are guilty of an even more heinous offense. In contrast, Christians know and take great comfort in the fact that Jesus does not change, He is the same yesterday, today and forever, He is the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the end, and He is Savior forever! Why would we want any other Jesus!? We know who He is, and how much He loves us, why would we want Him to be anything else?
